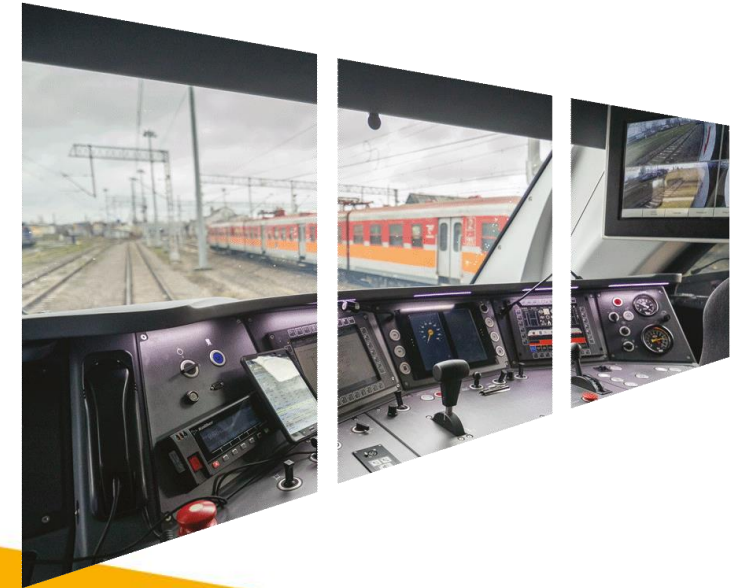
An excellent example of cooperation between local governments of the Lublin Region is the project of spatial, social and cultural revitalization of the Lublin Functional Zone. The project involved nine communes. Each of them, with the support of European funds, carried out comprehensive activities dedicated to the development of space and adaptation of degraded facilities. As a result, they received new functionality that meets the needs of the local community. An interesting example is the reconstruction of a historic 19th century estate in Strzyżewice. It is a part of the historical manor and park complex. It has just received a new look. The rooms of Ewa Kołaczkowska Commune Public Library, located in the estate have been renovated. The area around the building has also been well-planned and developed. In other communes that form a partnership, EU funds have allowed for the renewal and development of degraded areas, e.g. around the ruins of a Calvinist church "Kościelec "(Piaski), the adaptation of a part of the building offices of the Commune of Jabłonna for the needs of the Commune Public Library or construction of the Center for Social Activation in Spiczyn.

The purchase of electric multiple units

Lublin Voivodeship

The cost of the project: PLN 165 233 000,00

Co -Financing the EU project: PLN 130 329 336.51



These trains make you feel like travelling. There are already modern electric multifunctional installations on the railways of the voivodeship. The self-government of the Lublin Voivodeship has purchased 9 trains at European expense. Not only are they new and fast but also convenient, comfortable and safe. They are adapted to the needs of the disabled. The trains are equipped with ramps and induction loops necessary for people with low hearing. These economic, electric power units can run at a speed of up to 160 km/h. As many as 105 passengers can travel simultaneously in comfortable conditions. There will also be no problems with transportation of bicycles or larger luggage – to meet the demands there is universal space

From the passenger's point of view, however, the most important are ergonomic seats, air conditioning, access to Wi-Fi and sockets for charging electrical appliances. If you want to be one of the passengers, look for new train routes: Lublin -Kraśnik-Szastarka, Dęblin – Lublin - Chełm or Łuków - Terespol.

Expansion, reconstruction and maintenance historical and architectural complex - Vicarage in Kazimierz Dolny for social goals

St. Anna Charity Association in Kazimierz Dolny

The cost of the project: PLN 7 253 640.35

Co-financing of the EU project: PLN 4 775 132.65



The 18th century Vicarage is again the decoration of Kazimierz Dolny. Thanks to the efforts of the St Anna Charity Association in Kazimierz-Dolny, with the support of European funds, the city has gained a modern center for people who need help. The historical „Wikarówka” consists of three buildings: the former priest's house, shed and outbuilding. Today, they are used by families with disabled children or the elderly who need care. Thanks to this, not only does the monument decorate the area, but also offers sincere help to others. Upon completion of the reconstruction in 2021, the current „Wikarówka” is fully adapted to the needs of people with disabilities. All the residents of the center have the chance to participate in the culinary and drawing workshops or manual classes. The children of refugees from Ukraine, who are now in Kazimierz-Dolny, spend their free time as well.

The Formation of a Rehabilitation Center for people with shoulder pain with the use of Dosage Therapy Concept

Physiomed Anna Świtąła in Biłgoraj

The cost of a project: PLN 1 786 629.69

Co-financing of the project with the EU: PLN1 178 666,88



Almost everyone who has suffered from back or joint pain knows how important rehabilitation in everyday life is. Fizjomed Medical Center therapists focused on the rehabilitation of the shoulders and they are one of the leading specialists recognized outside the country. This would be impossible without the support of EU funds. Thanks to the financial support, the company was able to carry out research and design works that improve the quality of services. Today, Fizjomed is the only place in Poland and the second in Europe that has specialized equipment for shoulder-based therapy with biofeedback - David Shoulder Concept. It is a device that supports the Dosage Therapy Concept method designed thanks to the implementation of the EU project.

According to Fizjomed experts, the rehabilitation of the shoulder requires great accuracy of the treatment and recommended exercises. Only in this way will the recovery be as fast as possible, and the risk of microtraumas or secondary injuries during rehabilitation will be minimized.

Extension of a social self-help center "Kalina" in Lublin

The Commune of Lublin

Helping the weakest is one of the most important elements of a well-functioning society. Those who visit "Kalina" the center of social self-help know about it. In "Kalina" the elderly as well as people with disabilities can find help. The center has a specialized rehabilitation services and a clinic. Importantly, it is a place for spending time and living.

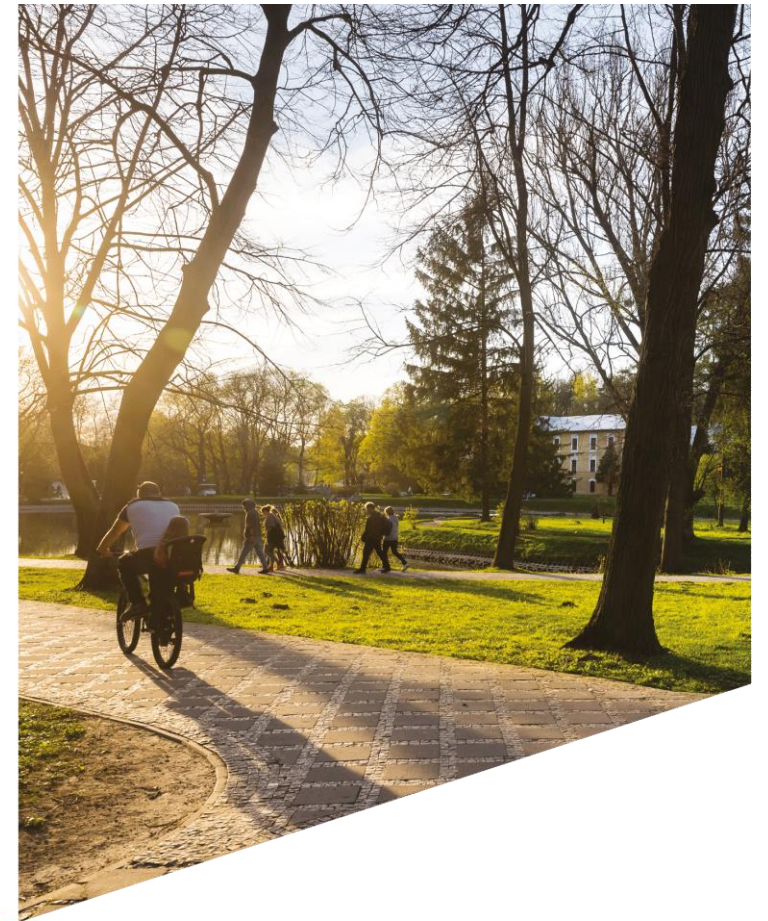
The classes in the center are conducted by experts who try to stimulate the residents there and give them an opportunity for further development. It is also a support for families and those who look after people suffering from Alzheimer's disease. The residents are provided with full nurse, nursing, rehabilitation and food service. In addition, a recreation area for periodic stay was created here.

Development of green space of historical resort park in Nałęczów

The Commune of Nałęczów

The cost of the project: PLN 1 962 429.70

Co-financing of the EU Project: PLN 1 516 055,54



Nałęczów is a well-known resort in Poland. The centers and spas that exist here specialize in the treatment of cardiovascular disease. Local microclimate helps to make a quick recovery here. This helps naturally to reduce blood pressure and reduce symptoms of heart disease.

Nałęczów is one of the treasures of the Lublin region. Therefore, we are all responsible for its durability and proper development. European funds also help to preserve its natural and resort qualities. The project implemented here contributed to the development of a historical resort park. New plantings of perennial, soil cover plants, undergrowth and ferns have been carried out. New flower beds were also created. Residents and patients are already looking forward to the results of this project.

Modernization of a delapidated facility of the indoor swimming-pool of the Sport and Leisure Centre in Kraśnik

The city of Kraśnik

Project Cost: 25 050 000,00 PLN

Co-financing of the project with the EU: 12 000 000,00 PLN.



The water park, swimming pool is an inextricable dream of sports and recreation lovers of every city. Kraśnik is no different. But here, thanks to European funds, dreams have become real. The indoor pool of the city Sport and Leisure Center finally will soon be renovated.

More functional saunas, a children's pool and a healing pool with a hydromassage will be modernized. Moreover, the main hall, the dining area, the front entrance to the building, cloakrooms, changing rooms and sanitary rooms, as well as rescuers' rooms and coaches' area will undergo serious change and renovation. In addition, the office building and terrace will be expanded. Large sums of money will be spent on the part of the investment that we will not see daily – the installations of the swimming-pool will be replaced or expanded. Upon completion the entire project, it will be an even greater landmark for the residents of Kraśnik and its visitors.

The construction of facilities for endangered animals in the zoological garden in Zamość, which is the border center of the quarantine and keeping illegally imported animals to Schengen zone - continuation of the implemented projects in 2009-2015 co-financed by the European Union European Union and Norwegian Financial Mechanism

The city of Zamość

The cost of the project: 31 493 866,41 PLN

Co-financing of the project with the EU: 18 695 403,31 PLN.



The list of novelties of the Zoo in Zamość, which, thanks to the attraction of European funds, has become accessible to visitors, is long. Today, we recall only some of them: a new building for flamingoes and an open aviary enclosure or new animal enclosures from America and Africa.

In 2021, new facilities were opened for visitors, which were built as part of the next stage of zoo expansion. During the walk, you can find an anthill, sloth or meadow dogs. In the aviary, you can please the free flight hall, where the birds fly directly above the heads of passers -by. All tenants here are properly equipped for themselves: rates, waterfalls, sandy beaches or rocky waterfronts.

Financial support from European funds allows to expand the zoo almost constantly. This, of course, increases the attractiveness of the institution, but also encourages visitors to visit Zamość and Lublin themselves. It's a must place to see.

Increasing the educational potential of 3 vocational schools of Biłgoraj district through the modernization works and purchase of new equipment

The Poviát of Biłgoraj

Project Cost: PLN 5 154 919.03

Co-financing of the EU project: PLN 2 697 975,94



The European funds invest in young people. Thanks to the subsidy, the vocational schools of Biłgoraj have purchased the modern equipment necessary for practical vocational training, which affects the efficiency of workshops. Thus, school graduates can easily find a job in their professions.

Biłgoraj's educational institutions have become richer, in particular, new milling, lathes, welding machines, computers, projectors, printer and 3D scanner are used to educate young people. The money of the European Union was allowed to equip stands and vehicles, buy engines on revolver stands and cars for training. Thanks to such investments, preparation for the profession becomes easier, students have better learning conditions, and teachers can give them their knowledge in a much easier way.

The adaptation of the former boarding school building for the museum purposes and organization of permanent exhibitions in 8 Wyspiańskiego street in Tomaszów Lubelski

Dr. Janusz Peter Regional Museum
in Tomaszów Lubelski

Co-financing of the EU project: PLN 1 131 520,12



Thanks to the European foundations, Tomaszów Lubelski has received another attraction both for the residents and tourists, which is a Dr. Janusz Peter regional museum. The museum is located in the premises of the former boarding school, modernized and adapted to the requirements of the cultural institution. The work was carried out inside and outside the building, so the museum looks great now. The roads and access roads to the building are well-groomed, the roads and parking space were fortified.

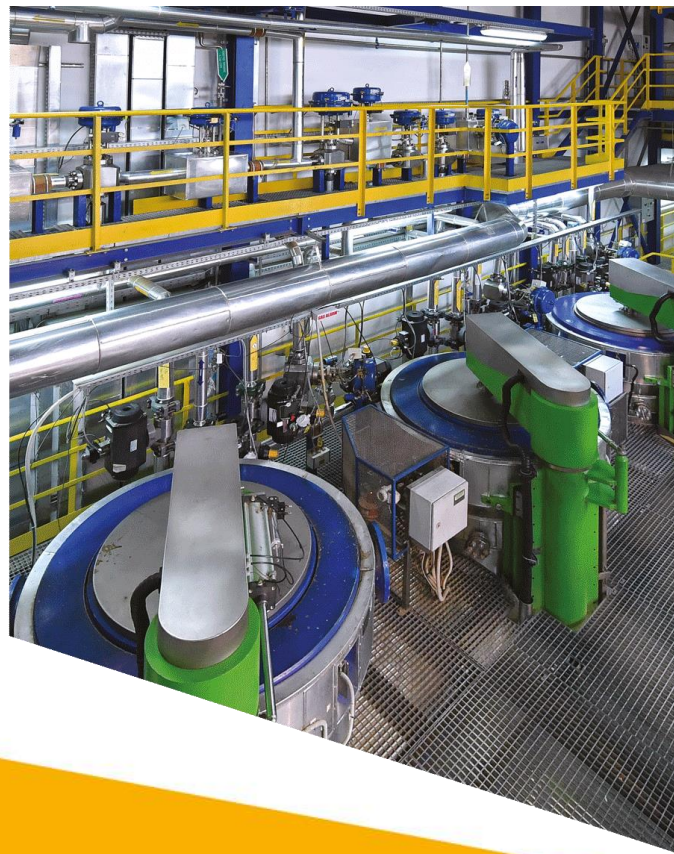
The rooms were adapted to the requirements of the museum. The exhibits look amazing. Importantly, the project has allowed for renovation of movable monuments. Museum premises are already used by children and young people who participate in museum lessons. On the other hand, temporary and permanent exhibitions are open to visitors daily.

Complex expansion of experimental and production installations for raw plant extracts

Łukasiewicz Research Network – Institute of New Chemical Synthesis in Puławy

The cost of the project: PLN 9 127 694.70

Co-financing of the project with the EU: PLN 5 596 150.08



The scientists from Łukasiewicz research network - the Institute of New Chemical Synthesis in Puławy know why carbon dioxide is used when producing vegetable raw materials. With the help of special catalysts vegetable oils and animal fats can be turned into more valuable chemicals. You can also deeply clean the raw material, also from chlorine and sulphur compounds. And it is precisely the preparation of trial batches of catalysts that can be used in the chemical processes which process raw materials that was the purpose of the EU-funded project. Before production, the Institute purchased the necessary equipment and equipment for analytical control of the extraction process. A company computer program was also developed to support the upgraded installation.

Thanks to the support of the European Funds, the Puławy Institute has been able to intensify cooperation with companies and research centers both in Poland and abroad. There was also money for the development of their own scientific staff.

Increasing the availability of lagoon in Zamość as a place of active rest in the surrounding of the old town complex in Zamość

The city of Zamość

Co-financing of the EU project: PLN 5 639 691.41



Outdoor places of active recreation have changed in recent years due to the support of the European Union. A great example of such investment is the city lagoon in Zamość. It is one of the most important natural complexes of the city and a place of recreation for the residents and tourists. Many attractions have been created here: pedestrian and cycle lanes with lighting and tribunes for two-wheeled vehicle. In order to observe the nature and enjoy the landscape, the observation decks were built. The guests can take pictures here and even immediately share them with friends. This is easy because wireless Internet is available here. There are Information boards and infoboxes reminding that endangered species live in the area. However, the local fauna does not suffer from the recreational operation of the lagoon. Animals living near the lagoon have areas covered with trees, shrubs and other plants, which provide safety and feeding areas. Bearing in mind the nature here, the European funds were used in order to help develop this area, according to the environmental regulations.

The Bear Square - the revival of the village of Adamów

The bears guard the revived Adamów center. Thanks to funds from European funds, they have a lot of work. Famous and beloved by the residents and tourists Bear Square has acquired a completely new look. And the effect can please every passer-by. The square includes: playground, amphitheater and park. Those who want to experience climbing wall, as well as those who love really extreme tests, can try their hand at the Tyrol Hill. Tired of this entertainment can be taken near the fountain.

The works also included landscaping and small architecture. All this promotes rest and relaxation in the bosom of nature. It should be emphasized that the updated space is adapted to the needs of people with disabilities. The Bear Square is now willingly visited by the residents and tourists.

And the bears? Well, these are metal casts that are the icing on the cake. You should see them.

Revitalization of the area at ul. Stefan Wyszyński in Świdnik as a direction in development of local entrepreneurship and strengthening its potential, including cultural one.

The city commune of Świdnik

Project Cost: 11 520 748.85 PLN

Co-Financing the EU project: 7 716 523.18 PLN



Another example of a perfectly spent money from the European Union can be found in Świdnik. Thanks to the thoughtful revitalization of the space, the city center has received a new infrastructure. You can use it, for example, in organizing cultural events and events. New plantings, sidewalks and benches tempting to rest, appeared in the Art Garden adjacent to the building of the Municipal Center for Social Services. Chess boards are waiting for the game lovers.

In the Zone of Art and Culture, the facilities necessary for active cultural life have been renovated. We can find cloakrooms, wardrobes and dance hall here. In the new space you can enjoy dance, acrobatic and drama classes. Those who wish can take part in the cultural events that are held here.

To recap, the residents of Świdnik, thanks to the EU subsidy, received great access to social services and infrastructure for their leisure.

It is common knowledge that our region has been the best place to relax for ages. The authors of many EU projects are also aware of that. As a result, many of these investments were aimed at increasing the tourist attractiveness of the community. A great example is "The Green Lof" - a project of five local self-government bodies aimed at increasing the attractiveness of green spaces and protecting biodiversity in the region. The partners who participated in the project performed the task of preventing the reduction of naturally valuable territories.

Let's see what they have achieved through the project. The Avia Park regained its beauty. New greens have been planted here, small architectural objects, including viewing towers and playground were built. There is also a cycle lane. In the commune of Wółka a tourist trail and a viewing point were created whereas in Lubartów - a Tourist Information Center was built.

In total, more than 60 km of cycle paths have been built, tourist sites have been rebuilt and adapted to the needs of people with disabilities. The places that have received new lives are often the property of cultural and natural heritage. These are the tourist landmarks that are estimated to be visited by thousands of people every year.

The First Steps with "Stonoga" centipede

Which parent would not like his child to take the first steps in the nursery during exceptional nature, art, speech therapy, or, for example, floral events? And if he or she was to be treated individually and helped to develop linguistically, musically and physically? That is what every single parent definitely wishes for. These are the dreams of the Stonoga kindergarten, which meets all the needs of the kids here, provides care for friendly and experienced nannies.

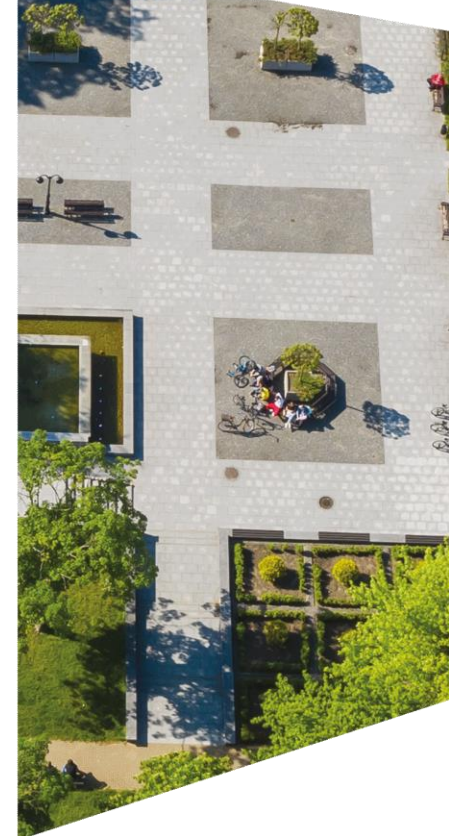
What can parents do at this time? They can get back to work or try their hand at their own businesses. That was exactly what the project assumed „First steps with Stonoga” which allowed parents of children under 3 years to start a job or keep it. Its authors - the social cooperative Stonoga and commune of Kraśnik – provided extra places for 15 children more in their nursery.

The total revitalization of the center of Ryki

The commune of Ryki

The cost of the project: PLN 19 025 514.79

Co-financing of the EU project: PLN 9 809 001.31



Just look how they take care of the "small homeland" of Ryki. The residents of this city, like many others, wanted to have a place for relaxation, recreation or to experience some culture. The European financial means made the dreams come true and the revitalization of the center of Ryki was no longer a dream but actually - the reality.

The former residence of the police department gains a new look. In the new version, the building in Poniatowski Street 12 will be used for social and cultural needs. The condition of the surrounding streets is going to be soon upgraded. All this part of the city will receive more greenery, and the updated sidewalks, new benches and birdhouses will inevitably be more welcoming for the residents and the guests of the city to spend their free time here. The restored city park will certainly contribute to the increased attractiveness of the urban space. Not only new pedestrian paths will be built but also an outdoor gym, houses for birds and insects. The park will be the perfect place for walking and relaxing close to nature.

Expansion of regional road no. 833 Chodel- Kraśnik. Stage 1 - connection with a ring road of Chodel (regional road no. 747) expansion and replacing the road to Kraśnik

Lublin Voivodeship

Project Cost: 90 264 688,48 PLN

Co-Financing of the EU project: 76 127 317.67 PLN



The residents of Kraśnik and neighboring cities have been waiting for this investment for years. Thanks to the EU funds, it was possible to expand the road connecting Kraśnik with Chodel. Almost 27 km of roads have been replaced. Many small cities have better communication with the rest of the region and the country. Heavy transport now is directed to ringroad of Kraśnik and then on the road Via Carpatia (state road S19), which connects, for instance: Lublin with Rzeszów.

The safety of all road users has also increased significantly. This is because not only drivers can feel comfortable. Pedestrians use new sidewalks and pedestrian crossings whereas buses have convenient stops. The construction of the rain sewage system and the installed devices also helped the environment.

Integrated Communication Center for the Lublin Functional Area

The commune of Lublin

The cost of the project: PLN 316 354 923.77

Co-financing of the project with the EU: PLN178 500 000,00.



The Modern Integrated Communication Center in the Lublin Voivodship rises. The railway station, which serves different types of public transport, is in the immediate vicinity of the Lublin railway station. It is here that residents and tourists will start their journey to almost all places of the province or country.

The project envisages the construction of the station, platforms, parking places and roads access. It will unite different types of public transport and dramatically change public transport in the whole region. The institution was designed as an intelligent building with comprehensive functional equipment, fully adapted to the needs of the disabled. There will also be underground parking. Moreover, the green roof of the building will serve as a tarrace for strolls. Special rainwater recovery system will provide water for watering plants and sanitary treatment.

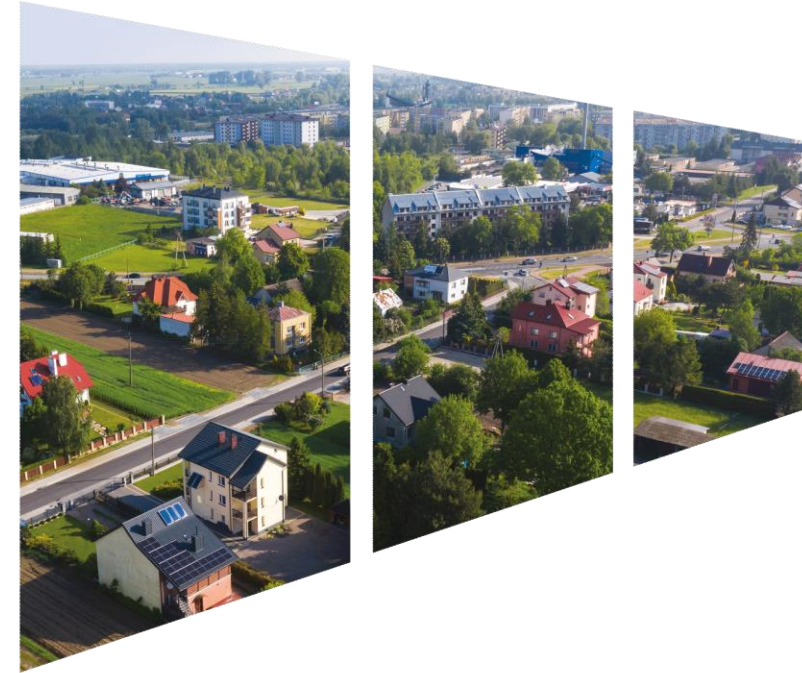
This construction will help to upgrade the railway station area. Therefore, a new space, friendly for travellers and residents, will be created. This is the key and one of the largest projects implemented with the participation of EU funds by the regional government and the city of Lublin.

The solar alternative for Radzyń Podlaski

The city of Radzyń Podlaski

Solar installations and photovoltaic panels are increasingly used by residents of Lublin to produce energy from the sun. Thousands of households have already taken advantage of their use. Thanks to the European funds, the residents of Radzyń Podlaski were also given this opportunity. The city has more than 3800 solar installations for heating communal water and about 80 photoelectric installations. The underlying aim of the idea is to reduce electricity costs and take care of the natural environment.

Modern methods of producing energy from renewable sources significantly reduce greenhouse gas emissions and carbon dioxide. Thanks to the project, the residents will breathe clean air and the neighborhood will become more attractive. By all means, we can confirm that Radzyń has gained a lot from his investment. We encourage you - take a look there.

The commune of Łuków

In the town of Klimki there is a place where you can have fun while studying. In this case, we can learn about the geological history of the region. Check it as it is so much worth it!

"Amonit" - the forest recreational and educational complex reminds that the ammonites are a treasure of the commune of Łuków. Hidden deep in the ground fossils of marine molluscs are over 166 million years old. They date back the course of Middle and Late Jurassic. And it was the ammonites that inspired the construction of tourist and recreational sites. Thanks to the support of the European Union, we can use an exhibition hall of a natural and geological character and also we can use the "Amonit" complex which includes tourist and educational trails and playground. There is also a well-maintained area that functions as a technical infrastructure, including parking space and entrance. The area of the whole complex is fenced and well-lit. Places such as "Amonit" are especially important in terms of facilitating access to the resources of cultural and natural heritage of the region. Simultaneously, they protect the natural diversity of the region.

The construction of sustainable public transport system within the city of Zamość, the commune of Zamość and neighbouring communes

The city of Zamość

The cost of the project: PLN 16 858 508.95

Co-financing of the project with the EU: PLN 11 258 972,02



Thanks to the European financial resources, a modern transport connecting point was built in the city of Zamość. This connecting point connects public and individual transport, including bikes. There is a parking lot for 100 cars which is of crucial importance due to the fact that the residents can leave their cars here and change the means of transport from a car to a low-emission bus. The project, funded by European Union, allowed to reconstruct the street of Peowiaków. Safe bicycle lanes, sidewalks and new bus parks have been established here. There are also new bus stops. It is worth paying attention to the fact that the public transport of Zamość has a modernized IT system that supports the designing of timetables. Thanks to all these changes, travelling became much more convenient.

The establishment of nursery school in the commune of Ryki creates a chance for the career advancement of parents and guardians

The commune of Ryki

The cost of the project: PLN1 587 246,36

Co-financing of the EU project: PLN1 349 159.40



As many as forty places for children under 3 years of age have been created in a new nursery school created by the local government of the commune of Ryki. The commune met the demands of parents who want to return to the labor market as soon as possible. But for the qualified and professional help, they would not have a chance to restart their careers.

The needs of local government officials have received a great deal of understanding of the institution responsible for European funds in Lublin. Co-financing of the Ryki project allowed to organize the new nursery school. Also, the kids received a modern-equipped playground with a safe coating.

The project designers have not forgotten about children with special educational needs. In the nursery school, they will have an opportunity to take part in special therapeutic activities.

Especially for their needs the nursery school has been equipped with tools that help to identify the needs of development and psychophysical abilities of children

Modernization and construction works on historical monuments of The Arian Tower – the Blacksmith Museum and the area planning around the facility

The Municipal Cultural Center in Wojciechów,
Local Tourist Organization "The land of Loess Gorges"

The cost of the project: PLN 875 994,07

Co-financing of the project with the EU: PLN 507 062,23



This building, built in the mid -16th century, was restored by means of European funds. The EU financial resources were also used to create the Alley of Honored Blacksmiths. The tower itself received updated stone supports and plaster.

In the historical walls of the tower there is a city cultural center in Wojciechów. Every day, he is the initiator and organizer of many events, especially those which promote Polish art of blacksmithing. Periodically there are meetings of Polish blacksmiths, during which the best Polish and foreign blacksmiths share their experience. Therefore, the tower and its surroundings are rich in many monuments related to this craft. Visitors can admire over a thousand exhibits of blacksmithing. There are also works progressing inside the facility. Their main aim is to purchase the equipment of the Blacksmith Museum. The culmination of the project will be the adaptation of the tower to the safe organization of shows, exhibitions and blacksmithing events.

Modernization of OSIR Tomasovia sports complex including modernization of degraded OSIR Tomasovia facilities and reconstruction of the OSIR gym building with administrative and social area

The city of Tomaszów Lubelski

The cost of the project: PLN 34 274 763.82
